Form 990, Part III, Line 4a, Program Service Accomplishments: partnerships help the groups increase their sustainability, raise awareness and establish built-in advocates. These groups continue to be a part of the systematic change process happening in their communities.

The Males of Color Quality Initiative Program at the University of Arkansas Pine Bluff had a 37% increase in program participants from fall of 2014 to fall 2015. The average GPA rate was 2.58. This is above the University's average for this particular group.

Mississippi Education Reform (MER), is a collaborative of five school districts including Jackson, Hattiesburg, McComb, East Jasper and Cleveland. Collectively, MER comprises more than 40,000 students and 3,000 teachers. The organization has been able to effectively reduce teacher turnover and increase new teacher retention through their Teacher Talent Identification program.

All seven graduating Alpha Knight Seniors, academically and socially qualified for a \$1,000 college scholarship. Alpha Knights is a mentoring program of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Monroe Chapter. It serves young men in grades 7th through 12th. The Chapter has 27 members, who are required to fulfill a community service component, in addition to individualized academic achievement.

Employer identification number Name of the organization Foundation for the Mid South, Inc. 72-1151070 participant, senior Chance Silvee was recruited by and offered full scholarships from 31 different colleges. He finished his high school credits early and enrolled in the University of Oklahoma as a freshman during the spring 2016 semester. Of the 70 students currently enrolled in the Our Kids program, in Monroe, LA, 59 were successfully promoted to the next grade level for a pass rate of 84%. Additionally, this program, which was designed by local law enforcement officials, saw 100% of those 59 boys have no continued involvement with the criminal justice system. Of the 28 current high school participants in the Delta Sigma Theta EMBODI program, seven of their junior/seniors were inducted into the National Honor Society. The Juanita Sims Doty Foundation ATEEM program is designed to help students achieve academic success. The program has expanded its reach through a partnership with the Top Ladies of Distinction and will now have chapters in following areas: Houston, TX; Cincinnati, OH; Inglewood, CA; East St. Louis, IL; and Washington, DC. Form 990, Part III, Line 4b, Program Service Accomplishments: aligned funds towards the workforce and economic development in boys and men of color in the state of Mississippi. To date, the program has achieved the following: built three industrial partnerships (healthcare, manufacturing and transportation); served 2,230 low income/low skill individuals in Mississippi; enrolled 1,377 people into post-secondary trainings; and placed 548 unique job seekers into

interns at the Jackson Free Press. The interns consisted of high school and college students interested in pursuing careers in journalism. The session covered the importance of and how to prepare budgets. There were eight students in attendance. A separate financial training session was conducted for staff of the Jackson Free Press. This session covered the following: developing a financial plan, settings goals, financial terms, as well as how to prepare a personal financial statement and monthly budget. There were ten staff members in attendance. On October 27, 2015, a financial training was held for New Way Mississippi, Inc. participants. There were approximately 30 participants from the reentry program in attendance. The financial training was conducted by Carl Snell and Willie Bell, financial planners for LPL Financial.
